I am recommending we approve the following Scholarship.

The Unadilla Presbyterian Integrity Award -- \$250/year

Recipient: One scholarship awarded to a graduating boy or girl from Unatego High School

Selection Criteria:

- The applicant must be a graduating senior with an average or above average academic standing.
- The applicant should have plans to continue his or her academic career at an institution of higher education. Selection preference will be given to a student who might plan to pursue a helping profession (e.g. nursing or social work) where the qualities of caring and compassion are essential.
- The applicant should exhibit the following qualities:
  1. Compassion - as demonstrated through involvement in church and or community activities
  2. Service - in organizations such as scouts, 4-H, Honor Society, or any other service organizations
  3. Attitude - displays a willingness to be of help to others in his or her daily life as exemplified by his or her actions of ethics, integrity and decision making in school, home and community

Selection: Selection will be at the sole discretion of the scholarship committee at the Unatego high School.
