Bus Lease Bid Results

On January 14, 2020, the Unatego Central School District voters approved the leasing of four buses, at an amount not to exceed \$100,000 per year, for a term not to exceed five years.

Earlier this month, a legal ad was placed, requesting bids.

Only one company responded with a bid: Mercedes-Benz Financial Services, USA, LLC. Mercedes-Benz Financial Services currently holds the financing for the district's other leased buses.

The total bid amount, for three large buses, one medium bus and one small bus, amounted to \$92,101.19 per year.

I recommend that the Board of Education award the bus lease bid to Mercedes-Benz Financial Services, USA, LLC.
