Re: Bus Lease Bid Results

On January 9, 2019, the Unatego Central School District voters approved the leasing of four buses, at an amount not to exceed \$80,000 per year, for a term not to exceed five years.

Last month, a legal ad was placed, requesting bids.

Two companies responded with bids: Mercedes-Benz Financial Services, USA, LLC and Santander Bank. Mercedes-Benz Financial Services currently holds the financing for the district's other leased buses.

Mercedes-Benz responded with slightly lower interest rates than Santander Bank.

The total bid amount, for three large buses and one small bus, amounted to \$70,093.32 per year.

I recommend that the Board of Education award the bus lease bid to Mercedes-Benz Financial Services, USA, LLC.
