

How-To Add a Video to a Webpage

Important to know: Video files tend to be very large. Depending on the file size, and your network speed, video may take a long time to upload. Once it is uploaded, it may take a while to convert to html5 format at eSchoolView . Once completely converted, it will display on the page and can be played

Please be aware this can be a long process and we suggest you begin the upload at a time when you can walk away from your computer for a time.

Prerequisites: must have a video file compressed to an appropriate format and under 1GB in size


Steps:

+ Add a Page Component


Choose **Streaming Video** from **Type** Dropdown

Give it an **Internal Name**

Save



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1. Be sure your **file type is supported**. Check *(most are...)*
2. Add a **Video Title**
3. Add a **Video Caption** if desired. *(Title and caption will appear above the video)*
4. **Autoplay** option *(video will play automatically when the page loads)*
5. Browse to **Choose** the video file *(Be careful naming video files! Odd or extra characters will throw up an error warning. Keep it simple- numbers and letters only)*

6. Click **Save** and **OK** on the pop up window



7. **WAIT**

Note: The screen may look frozen. There is little indication that the files are uploading. You may be logged out while waiting. This is normal (*especially for large files*). Please read the notice at the top
