

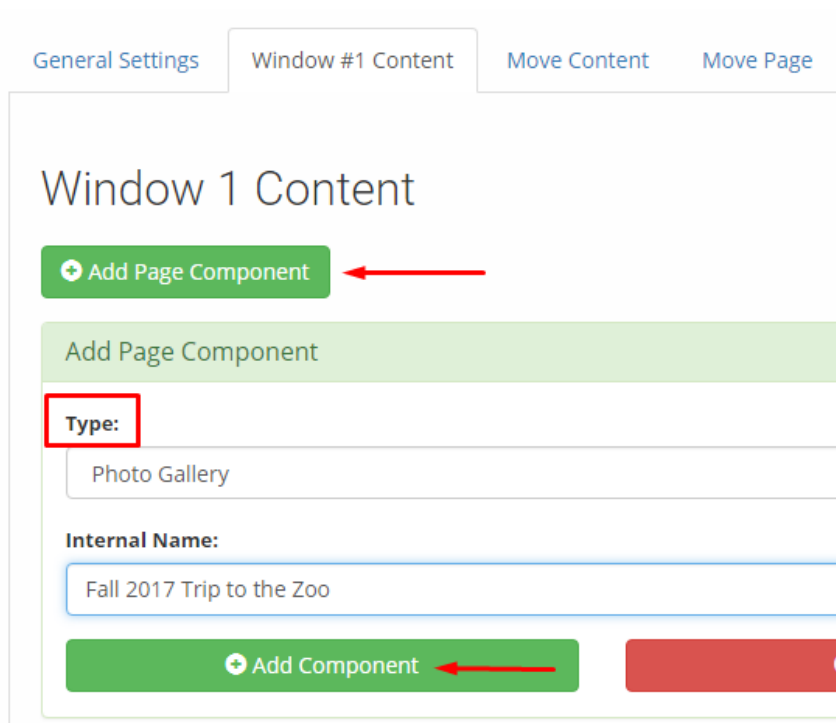
Summary: The Photo Gallery Page Component will allow you to add images to your page as thumbnails or as a rotating slide show. The images are automatically resized as they upload from your computer.

Prerequisites: Must have login credentials and access to a page

Steps

1. Once you are in Edit View of the page and window where you want the Photo Gallery to be placed, choose to **+Add Page Component/ Type/ Photo Gallery/ + Add Component**

Optional: Give it an Internal Name (*not public*)

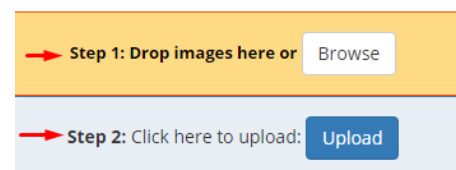

2. Click the green **Edit** button to the right of the Component Name

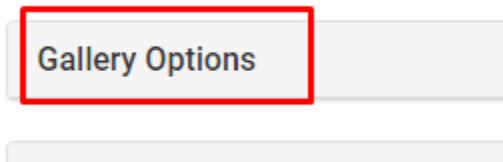

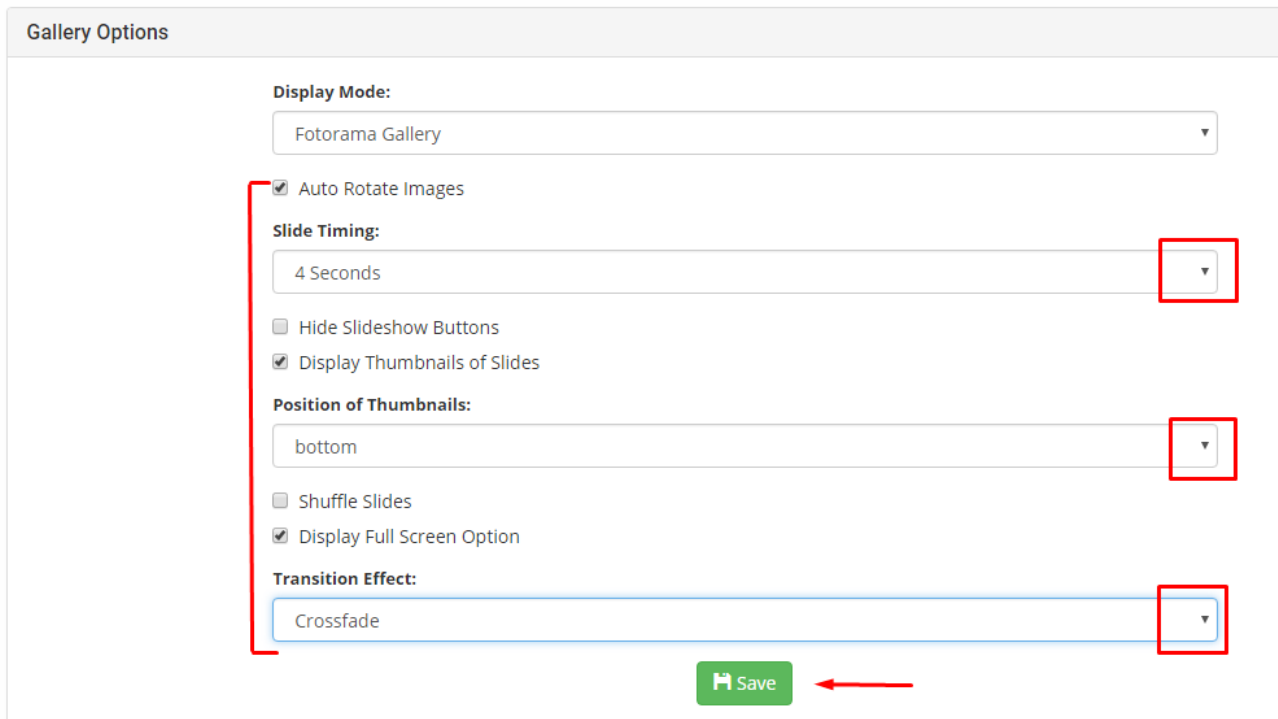

9. Choose either **Fotorama** (rotating slideshow) **Gallery** or **Lightbox Thumbnails**. If you choose Lightbox thumbnails, there are no configuration options.

10. If you chose the Fotorama Gallery there are many display options. Set these and click **Save**

Lightbox Thumbnails is recommended if you've added many images
