Rules:

Class Tardiness:

Homework:

Homework is designed for individual practice/review of skills or information, or to prepare for upcoming content. Homework will be assigned at the discretion of the teacher and assignments will be checked or chosen at random for grading. The majority of the homework in this course will be studying diagrams and practicing terms.

Absence:

It is the **student's responsibility** to find out what was missed. Work should be made up as soon as possible. Absent students should check with the teacher for items that they may have missed. Students must comply with the school attendance policy to receive credit for the course.

Extra Help:

If you feel that you need extra help or if you don't understand any material, please make an appointment to come see me. I am very willing to work with you if you also put forth the effort.

Summative Assessment Policy:

All students will have the opportunity to re-take or re-do summative assessments (tests, quizzes, labs & projects). A summative assessment may only be retaken/redone once. If the NEW grade is HIGHER, it will be AVERAGED with the ORIGINAL grade. If the NEW grade is LOWER, it will REPLACE the ORIGINAL grade. In order to be eligible for a re-take or re-do, students must meet with Ms. Costello during a tutorial period to discuss the reasoning for the original poor performance. This must be done within one week of the date of the original summative assessment. If a student fails to show for their scheduled re-take or missed the deadline for a re-do, additional attempts will not be allowed.
