allows for either 1 (Figure A) or 2 (Figure B) Content Windows. Content Windows are the content managed columns on each page of the website.

In order to place content on a page, such as text, links, documents or images, Page Components must be added and populated within the Content Windows.



2 Window Page


#### **Terms to Know**

**Content Managed** refers to anything on the website in which a user is able to edit, update, or delete within the Content Management System.

**Page Components** are blocks of content stacked upon one another within Content Windows 1 & 2.

**Content Windows** are the columns that make up a page. Each page will always have a left navigation, which is made up of Touts and/or the Dynamic Navigation.
