## **New Owner for Otego Elementary**

On November 4th the Unatego Board of Education ended a three-year quest to find a suitable owner for the Otego Elementary School. The meeting was filled with joy and relief as the Board of Education unanimously named the Oneonta Christian Academy the winning bid.

It was a hard three years. Closing a school is never easy.

Rural schools are the heart of any community. Many families have a multi-generational connection to Otego Elementry, built in 1933. It's sad to let go of a building that houses so many memories. However, times change. The District that once had 1,450 students twenty years ago now has 717.

Keeping three schools open with empty classrooms doesn't make economic sense.

A previous Request for Proposals (RFP) in May 2018 brought in 4 bidders. After one dropped out, the Board split 4 to 3 in favor of an indoor agriculture concern from Endicott, NY over a private school for dyslexia based in Amenia, NY. Ultimately the winning bidder failed to come up with financing and the school in Amenia closed due to financial difficulties. The District had to start again.

## **Unatego Announces Sixth Class for Hall of Distinction**

The Unatego Hall of Distinction Committee has selected two alumni to be honored for induction this year. This year's inductees include an outstanding high school and collegiate athlete from the class of 1983 who went on to excel as a mechanical engineer and a 2010 graduate who went on to become a very successful professional musician.

The Unatego Hall of Distinction honors graduates of Unatego or from previous districts of Unadilla Central and Otego Central who have distinguished themselves through recognition, honor, and distinction during their lives.

The selections were announced on Friday, June 21 at the High School Graduation Ceremonies. The actual induction ceremony honoring the newest members will take place Saturday January 11<sup>th</sup> at the High School during the Wickham Wrestling Tournament.

#### Steve Hall

Steve Hall was a 1983 graduate of the Unatego High School where he excelled in wrestling and football, finishing 7th place at the New York State Wrestling Championship his senior year. He continued his athletic career at Worcester Polytechnic Institute as a four year varsity wrestler, finishing as a four-time All-New England wrestler and helping his team to New England Champions in 1985 and 1987. He also earned honors in his senior year as an Academic All-American. A successful student throughout his time at WPI, he earned professional accolades throughout his career as a mechanical engineer, owning two U.S. Patents, and serving as the President of the International Association for SMT Equipment Development and finished his technology career as the President of EKRA America, Inc. He then returned to his alma mater where he went on to serve as the head coach of the WPI Wrestling Team, leading them to 93 victories in his eight years as head coach. Culminating with his winning honors as the New England Wrestling Association and National Wrestling Coaches Association northeast Region Coach of the Year.

#### **Aaron Foster**

Aaron "Frosty" Foster, a 2010 graduate of Unatego, grew up listening to Bluegrass music and received his first guitar as a Christmas present when he was ten. Aaron, a Wells Bridge native, has always been interested in music and Bluegrass in particular. While enrolled in Eastern Tennessee State University studying Business Management, he took several music electives, ultimately leading to his graduation with a degree in Interdisciplinary Studies, with a minor in Bluegrass, Old Time, and Country Music Studies. While in college, Aaron played guitar in the ETSE Bluegrass Pride Band, in which he earned recognition by being part of the making of two Bluegrass Today Top 20 singles. He continued to pursue his music career after college, producing two albums and several singles, including Reaping the Blues and Opening Doors. He played guitar for several years as a member of the band Dreamcatcher, and most recently joined the Amanda Cook Band as a quitarist.
